The **ultimate aim** of the project is to help schools and sixth-form colleges across Norfolk to create and develop an allotment growing area which the children and young people will design, create and develop themselves. **The Papillon Project** is also about creating a shared responsibility and forging a community of volunteers from amongst staff, parents and the wider community to help develop a school allotment and maintain it for future children and young people who attend the school. A period of 'hard help' which creates the allotment is followed by a

term of 'growing'. The schools will become part of a network across Norfolk and have access to information, advice and training.
