Wensum Residents Association Parks Committee (WRAP) have the main aim of supporting the development and maintenance of five parks in the NR2 area.

These parks are

West End Gardens – (opposite the Fat Cat)

West End Park – a short walk from West End Gardens bordered by West End Street and Northumberland Street

Wensum View Park – directly behind Wensum Junior School and accessed from Dereham Road

Wensum Community Centre Gardens – directly behind the Community Centre

St Bartholomew's Park – bordered by Heigham Street, Northumberland St and the north end of Nelson Street

We held a 'street party' last year to develop a 'friend's group' which was highly successful, and we now have 60

members. We have held public meetings to gather information about what the local community want for their local parks and will continue to do so. Last November we planted daffodil bulbs in one of our parks and more recently have been awarded a government grant of £25,500 to develop West End Gardens, a small park bordered by West End Street, Adelaide Street and Nelson Street. We are doing so in partnership with Norwich City Council. We are hoping to organise a 'Bee Day' soon to encourage the planting of insect pollinator friendly plants in both public parks and private gardens.
