Established in 1991 **the Norwich Fringe Project** is a local authority funded countryside management partnership, working with volunteers, local communities and parish councils to look after the countryside around Norwich. The Norwich Fringe Project also supports many of the Friends Groups within the OPN.

We provide a full Countryside Management Service, looking after a range of habitats and sites including woodlands, meadows, marshes, heathlands and ponds supported by our dedicated team of volunteers. We look after and manage Norwich City Councils 55 natural areas, as well as working in partnership with South Norfolk District Council and Broadland District Council We also work in partnership with Norfolk County Council and carry out other project work.

The activities vary according to season with mainly woodland work during Autumn/Winter and grassland and footpath maintenance during the Spring/Summer months. Infrastructure works and repairs to things such as fencing, boardwalks, kissing and field gates take place throughout the year. We provide opportunities for regular volunteering that includes training and learning through countryside management related activities. We also offer business volunteer workdays, allowing organisations to give something back to their local community.
